M: Good afternoon, ladies and gentlemen. This is Captain Jason Chang again. We will begin our descent into Hong Kong International Airport in about 15 minutes. Depending on the instructions from the air traffic controllers, we expect to be landing at about 3 o'clock. Remain seated with your seat belt fastened. On behalf of all of us at Star Air, thank you for flying with us.

M: Questions 25 and 26 are based on the following talk.

W: A global food shortage is coming. There is no possible way to produce enough food to feed the world's population under the current system. Already 1 billion people in the world go to bed hungry every single night. Already somewhere in the world someone starves to death every 3.6 seconds and 3/4 of them are children under the age of 5. Already approximately a third of all children in the world under the age of five suffer from serious malnutrition. And the bad news is that the world simply does not have enough water to grow much more food.

W: Carl Sandburg, the poet, was born in Illinois. His parents had emigrated from Sweden. Sandburg dropped out of school at the end of eighth grade and went to work to help support the family by delivering milk and newspapers. But he wanted to travel. He hid on trains and traveled throughout the Midwest, and even to Colorado. His most well-known works were written for his children. His daughters couldn't understand European fairy tales, especially those about kings and queens. Therefore, he wrote stories about American things, such as skyscrapers and trains.

W: Plastic is something that most of us use every day. But experts say, for the environment, plastic is a serious problem. A recent study found that more than eight million tons of plastic waste has entered the world's oceans. And that's putting our sea life in a really risky situation. Many sea birds and marine mammals die from plastic every year. Unlike paper or cardboard, plastic takes a long time to break down. So the United Nations wants people to avoid single-use packaging and encourages people to clean up their local beaches. The Taiwanese government has also set up rules to ban most retailers from providing free plastic bags and encourages citizens to avoid using plastic straws.

M: The Mitchell Museum of the American Indian will offer special activities for children during spring vacation from April 3rd to April 6th. Kids can engage in do-it-yourself art and craft projects, making traditional Native American items such as woven rugs and masks. Native American stories will be read each afternoon at 2 p.m. in the museum's Reading Room. All activities are included in the price of the admission, which is 5 dollars for adults and 3 dollars for children and students. Admission is free for Mitchell Museum members and tribal members. The museum is open 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., Tuesdays through Fridays, and noon to 4 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays. The museum is closed on Mondays.

M: ONLY \$3.99? They're still expensive. Those imported apples in the front are just half the cost.

W2: Well, that's true, but they're different. Those are conventionally grown apples. These organic apples are local and are safer and tastier.

M: But are they really worth the extra cost?

W2: I think so. Organic apples need more human labor than conventional ones. That's why they generally cost more. Plus, organic farmers don't use chemical fertilizers, harmful pesticides, or herbicides which is better for us and for the environment. So I prefer organic apples.

M: I can see your point, but I just don't trust the sellers. They may use words like, "organic" or "natural" just to attract customers. How do we really know their products are grown organically?

W2: Well, real organic products are certified by the government and are allowed to use the organic label. Like this one, it's labeled "USDA organic," meaning that it meets the strict regulations set by the US government.

M: Whether you are a sociable person or not, making small talk is a part of life. Like it or not, sometimes you're going to find yourself in a situation where you just have to get a conversation going with a new acquaintance.

Luckily, there are plenty of useful tips for starting a conversation. One powerful way is to ask open-ended questions – questions that can't be answered with a simple "yes" or "no," or a single word like "okay" or "right."

Sometimes, though, it can be tricky to come up with suitable open-ended questions. In these situations, you can use the F-O-R-M acronym, which stands for "family," "occupation," "recreation," and "miscellaneous." The first three of these are fairly straightforward. The last one, "miscellaneous," is the one that allows for the most creativity on your part. For example, you could ask your new acquaintance if she's read any interesting books or seen any great movies recently.

Questions like these are far more likely to lead to an actual conversation. If you want to learn more about how to make small talk or how to choose the right word in your conversation, please read *The Fine Art of Small Talk*, by Debra Fine.
